Your DBE certification applies only for the above code(s). Any additions and revisions must be submitted to VTA for review and approval. As of August 01, 2013, issuance of DBE Certificates has been discontinued. A copy of a printout from the DBE Database should be sufficient proof of a firm's certification.


Your certification will remain in effect provided that your firm, Accend Networks, continues to meet the eligibility criteria as established by the Federal Regulation Title 49 CFR Part 26. In order to assure continuing DBE status, you must submit annually an Annual Update Declaration form (which will be sent to you), along with supporting documentation affirming that there have been no changes within your firm that would affect your current eligibility as a DBE. It is your responsibility to notify this office in writing within 30 days on any changes related to your firm i.e., firm's name, business and mailing address, ownership, management/control, or failure to meet the applicable business size standards or personal net worth standard. Failure to submit notification(s), form(s) or requested documentation will be deemed a failure to cooperate under Section 26.109 of the Regulations and may result to your firm's decertification.

VTA reserves the right to withdraw this certification if, at any time, it is determined that it was knowingly obtained by false, misleading, or incorrect information. DBE certification is subject to review at any time. The firm thereby consents to the examination of its books, records, and documents by VTA.
